
b. CAFTH Updates

Julie Meiman reminded attendees that the cafth.org website contains many helpful items under the Resources tab. She highlighted different features of this section and the training courses included for providers.

Kirsten Hipkins provided an overview of the Coordinated Entry system and the "no wrong door" approach. She also discussed the definition and purpose of Diversion, as an approach to prevent people from becoming unsheltered. Diversion will become a regular part of discussion at future Outreach Meetings, with a goal of creating a formal diversion process within our Coordinated Entry system.
