WHAT GOES IN A CARE BAG?



We will be assembling care bags with donated items and distributing them to people seeking services during Point-in-Time Count and Project Homeless Connect.

This is what they will look like.





Each pack will contain *travel sized* personal hygiene products, including: toothbrush, toothpaste, deodorant, shampoo, conditioner, soap, and washcloth.

1 2) COLD WEATHER GEAR



Each pack will contain cold weather gear, including blankets, gloves, beanies, hand warmers, and socks.



3) EXTRAS



Based on the donations we recieve, we will include extras! We always include a snack for all bags, and often include things like chapstick, water bottles, hydration powders, masks, and/or any other items that are helpful for general wellbeing.



One of the most important pieces of the care bag is the bag itself. This holds all of the other items together, and is useful for recipients even once the other items get used up.
